In France

Doctor Truyet Thanh Mai earned his doctorate degree in Organic Structural Chemistry at the Besancon University, France in 1973.

In Vietnam

Right after his graduation and before Vietnam was totally controlled by the Communist party in April 1975, he then returned to Vietnam and worked for Saigon University as Associate Professor, and became the Dean of Chemistry Department for Pedagogy Faculty for two years, and during this time, he also was Director of Academic Affairs at the Cao Dai University, westbound of Saigon. He tugged in Saigon for about 8 years and was the advisor of a Science Committee; he then was released in 1982.

In USA

Dr. Mai went to USA in 1983, he was hired by Minnesota Medical School, Minneapolis, as Research Associate/Post Doctorate funded by National Institute of Health (NIH) until 1987. He then decided to move to California where he could meet and work with the Vietnamese community as a political activist and environmental lobbyist to free Vietnam from Communist regime by using environment approach, and at this time, Vietnam got into deep trouble of waste management, water, public utilities, and city development...He quickly changed and focused on global environmental research.

- **Environmental Management Specialist** – He successfully worked for different companies related to environmental management, in the upper level of policymaker or executive business decision maker, in the state of California base: Chemical Waste Management, Inc., Weck Environmental Laboratories, Inc., and SCS/BKK Landfill, Environment Services, Inc.
- **Community Activist** – Dr. Mai, member of WHO's WHO since 1993, is active in community services. He holds the office of the Chairman of VAST, Inc. (Vietnamese American Science and Technology, a California non-profit organization). He also is the Consultant for Science and Environment of Radio Free Asia (RFA), Washington, USA.
- **Environmental Educator** – Helping the Vietnamese people in USA and Vietnam understanding the most current updated issues of environmental management from a different scientific approach, Dr. Mai creates a website in Vietnamese & in English for different Vietnamese generations. He also writes a series of environmental issues in Vietnamese with the hope that serves as a wakeup call for Vietnam before it is too late to correct.
